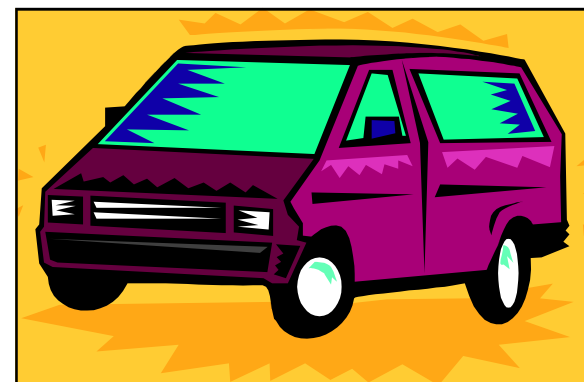

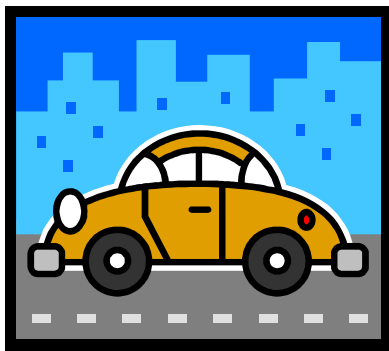

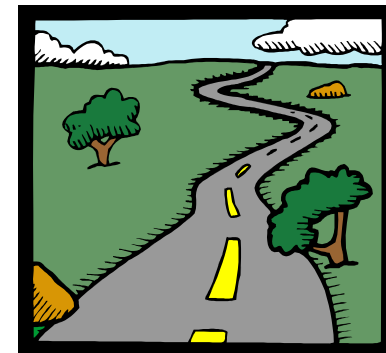
## For single Catholic women Ages 18-40
